AN ACT

To amend chapter 567, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the offense of prostitution.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 567, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 567.125, to read as follows:

567.125. 1. No prosecutor shall make prostitution a felony offense if at the time of the crime the offender was under the control of an agent.

- 2. If a person was previously charged with felony prostitution, he or she may request a court hearing to be heard on the issue of whether that prostitution charge may be expunged because he or she was acting under the authority of an agent at the time of the offense.
- 3. As used in this section, "agent" means a person who solicits customers for a prostitute, usually in return for a share of the earnings.
