4 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain county boards of education to establish a regional 5 Career and Technical Education (CTE) school subject to certain requirements; 6 requiring a regional CTE school to comply with certain provisions of law and 7 regulation; requiring a regional CTE school to operate under the terms of a certain 8 collective bargaining agreement; requiring the Interagency Commission on School 9 Construction to study and develop a certain cost-share formula for certain county boards of education; requiring the Commission to submit a report with its findings 10 11 and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a 12 certain date; defining certain terms; and generally relating to establishing a regional 13 CTE school for public high school students in Caroline County, Dorchester County, 14 Kent County, Queen Anne's County, and Talbot County.

- 2 DORCHESTER COUNTY, KENT COUNTY, QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, AND TALBOT

- 29 GOVERNING OTHER PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
- 30 (2) A REGIONAL CTE SCHOOL SHALL OPERATE UNDER THE TERMS
- 31 OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY BOARD AND
- 32 THE EXCLUSIVE BARGAINING REPRESENTATIVE THAT IS IN EFFECT IN THE COUNTY
- 33 WHERE THE SCHOOL IS LOCATED.

(a) The Interagency Commission on School Construction shall study and develop a State and local cost—share formula for county boards of education that choose to collaborate and operate a regional school involving one or more county boards.

- (b) On or before January 1, 2021, the Interagency Commission on School Construction shall submit a report with its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
- 7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2020.
