A RESOLUTION

- 1 Supporting the infrastructure plan presented by the President of the United States; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Trump Administration is committed to creating a safe, fast, reliable, and
- 4 modern infrastructure in order to meet the needs of the American people and the economy;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, the administration's proposal will spur at least \$1.5 trillion of investment
- 7 opportunities in order to address our crumbling infrastructure, thereby permanently fixing
- 8 the infrastructure deficit and preparing the United States for opportunities that lie ahead; and
- 9 WHEREAS, this proposal will fix the broken permit process within the United States of
- 10 America, which has degraded from taking as little as one year to build the Empire State
- Building to one that can take up to ten years simply to gain approval to build a highway; and
- 12 WHEREAS, by streamlining the permitting and approval process, and lowering it to no more
- 13 than two years, America may become a global leader in infrastructure; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the proposal will return the responsibility of decision making to the states,
- 15 empowering states and localities to invest in infrastructure projects that they want without
- 16 the burden of having the federal government impede their creativity, add costs, or slow down
- 17 the overall process; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it will designate \$100 billion as matching funds for state, local, and private
- 19 investments, and will broaden existing authorities in order to delegate environmental review
- and permitting responsibilities to the states; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the proposal dedicates \$50 billion toward allowing rural America to address its
- 22 unique infrastructure challenges, and \$20 billion toward spurring competition centered

around bold, innovative, and transformative infrastructure projects that will dramatically

- 24 improve future infrastructure; and
- 25 WHEREAS, it will allow new projects to be generated that will lead to an increase of
- 26 employment within the construction industry, and which will broadly boost the demand for
- 27 labor; and
- 28 WHEREAS, the proposal will be committed to helping more individuals gain access to
- 29 affordable, relevant, and quality education which will lead to skill development, full-time
- 30 work opportunities, and long-term careers by expanding Pell Grant eligibility to high-quality,
- 31 short-term programs and by reforming licensing requirements for individuals seeking an
- 32 infrastructure project job.
- 33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 34 support the infrastructure plan presented by the President of the United States.
- 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 36 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
- 37 press.
