## A BILL

To provide grants to law enforcement agencies for de-escalation training and community outreach, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Community Policing
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DE-ESCALATION TRAINING AND COMMUNITY OUT-
- 7 REACH GRANT PROGRAM.
- 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General shall make
- 9 grants to law enforcement agencies for the purposes of

- 1 providing de-escalation training and community outreach
- 2 as described in subsection (c).
- 3 (b) APPLICATION.—To receive a grant under this sec-
- 4 tion, a law enforcement agency shall submit to the Attor-
- 5 ney General an application at such time, in such manner,
- 6 and containing such information as the Attorney General
- 7 may require.
- 8 (c) Use of Funds.—Grants awarded under this sec-
- 9 tion may be used—
- 10 (1) to provide de-escalation training; and
- 11 (2) to facilitate community outreach initiatives
- between the law enforcement agency and the com-
- munity that the agency serves.
- 14 (d) Priority.—In making grants under this section,
- 15 priority shall be given to law enforcement agencies with
- 16 high crime rates.
- 17 (e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
- 18 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this Act,
- 19 \$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2021 through 2025,
- 20 of which—
- 21 (1) \$7,500,000 shall be for de-escalation train-
- ing; and
- 23 (2) \$2,500,000 shall be for community out-
- reach.
