BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Transportation Section 25–108 Annotated Code of Maryland (2020 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement)
BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Chapter 121 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2023 Section 2
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - Transportation
25–108.
(a) In this section, "HOV lane" means a high occupancy vehicle lane designated by the State Highway Administration whose use is restricted by a traffic control device during specified times to vehicles carrying at least a specified number of occupants.

This section applies only to a plug-in electric drive vehicle that has a

maximum speed capability of at least 65 miles per hour.

- (c) A plug—in electric drive vehicle for which a permit has been applied for and obtained from the Administration under this section may use an HOV lane at all times regardless of the number of passengers in the vehicle.
- 4 (d) (1) The Administration, the State Highway Administration, and the 5 Department of State Police may consult to design a permit to designate a vehicle as a 6 plug—in electric drive vehicle authorized to use an HOV lane.
- 7 (2) The Administration shall charge a fee, not to exceed \$20, for issuing a 8 permit under this section.
- 9 (3) The Administration, on the recommendation of the State Highway 10 Administration, may limit the number of permits issued to ensure HOV lane operations are 11 not degraded to an unacceptable level.
- 12 (e) On or before January 1 each year, the Administration and the State Highway
 13 Administration jointly shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the
 14 State Government Article, the General Assembly on the effect of the use of the plug–in
 15 electric drive vehicle permits issued under this section on the operation of HOV lanes in
 16 the State.

Chapter 121 of the Acts of 2023

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective through September 30, [2025] **2030**, and, at the end of September 30, [2025] **2030**, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
