- 20 Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, a veterans' 21organization issued a license under this subsection shall purchase or lease the instant 22ticket lottery machines to be used by the veterans' organization.
- 23An organization may not use receipts from the sale of tickets from instant ticket lottery machines that would otherwise be credited to the State Lottery 2425Fund for the costs of purchasing or leasing instant ticket lottery machines.
 - The Director may adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this subsection that include restricting the location of instant ticket lottery machines in areas of a veterans' organization's OR FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION'S public meeting hall that is accessible to the public.
- 30 The Agency shall ensure that the element of chance in the conduct of the gaming through the instant ticket lottery machines established under this subsection 31 32 is consistent with the holding in the case of Chesapeake Amusements Inc. v. Riddle, 363 33 Md. 16 (2001), in that the element of chance must be wholly within the pre-printed instant 34 lottery ticket, and that player enhancements in an instant ticket lottery machine may not 35 affect the element of chance being wholly within the pre-printed instant lottery ticket.

- 1 (e) The Director may not issue a license to:
- 2 (1) a person or governmental unit to engage in business primarily as a 3 licensed agent; or
- 4 (2) an individual who is under the age of 21 years.
- 5 (f) The Commission may hear and decide an appeal of a denial of a license.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that, when the State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency solicits proposals for the lease or purchase of instant ticket lottery machines under this Act, the Agency solicit proposals from multiple vendors.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
