### A RESOLUTION

Recognizing National Crime Victims' Rights Week in Ohio,  
April 2-8, 2017.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 1  
132nd General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize April 2-8, 2  
2017, as National Crime Victims' Rights Week in Ohio; and 3

WHEREAS, In an effort to increase public knowledge of, and 4  
pay tribute to, crime victims and survivors, National Crime 5  
Victims' Rights Week was first designated by the U.S. Congress in 6  
April of 1984, with commemorative legislation passed each year 7  
since. Americans are victims of more than 20 million crimes each 8  
year. Affecting individuals of all races and socio-economic 9  
backgrounds, these events have long-lasting repercussions, not 10  
only for victims and their families but also for communities and 11  
society as a whole; and 12

WHEREAS, Our system of justice is founded on the principle 13  
of "justice for all" citizens, and although our nation has worked 14  
to expand rights and services for victims of crime, we must 15  
continue to strive to ensure that these same protections are 16  
available for all members of our population. Victims with 17  
disabilities and mental illness, those who are teenagers or are 18  
elderly, and those who live in rural areas or have different 19  
ethnic backgrounds must be treated with dignity and respect, as 20  
must all crime victims and their families; and 21

WHEREAS, In order to prevent the escalation of crime in the 22  
future, it is vital for all concerned citizens to join in 23  
educating the general public, including potential offenders, about 24

the effects of crime and in developing a general consciousness 25  
regarding its far reaching devastation. In observance of this 26  
year's commemoration, we ask all Ohioans to support and 27  
participate in events throughout their communities; therefore be 28

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the House of 30  
Representatives of the 132nd General Assembly of Ohio, in adopting 31  
this Resolution, recognize April 2-8, 2017, as National Crime 32  
Victims' Rights Week in Ohio; and be it further 33
