SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the state imposes sales and use taxes upon certain persons, firms, and corporations. The state also imposes a sales tax on the operation of places of amusement or entertainment. Counties and municipalities impose various additional sales and use taxes. Certain entities are exempted from state, county, or local sales and use taxes.

This bill would exempt the Community Foundation of Northeast Alabama, from all state, county, and municipal fees and taxes.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to taxes, to exempt the Community Foundation of Northeast Alabama, from the payment of all state, county, and municipal fees and taxes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. The Community Foundation of Northeast
2 Alabama is exempted from paying all state, county, and
3 municipal fees and taxes.

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
5 first day of the third month following its passage and
6 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
