A BILL

To provide supplemental appropriations relating to border security, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
- 4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
- 5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, for the following
- 6 purpose, namely:

9	by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
