Mr. ROGERS of Alabama (for himself and Mr. HIGGINS of Louisiana) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations, and in addition to the Committee on the Budget, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To provide supplemental appropriations relating to border
security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, for the following
6 purpose, namely:

1 DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE

2 MILITARY PERSONNEL

3 NATIONAL GUARD PERSONNEL, ARMY

4 For an additional amount for “National Guard Per-
5 sonnel, Army”, for necessary expenses to respond to the
6 significant rise in unaccompanied minors and family unit
7 aliens at the southwest border and related activities,
8 \$172,056,000: *Provided*, That such amount is designated
9 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
10 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
11 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided further*,
12 That the amount provided under this heading shall be
13 available only if the President designates such amount as
14 being for an emergency requirement pursuant to section
15 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

16 OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

17 OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, ARMY

18 For an additional amount for “Operation and Main-
19 tenance, Army” for necessary expenses to respond to the
20 significant rise in unaccompanied minors and family unit
21 aliens at the southwest border and related activities,
22 \$135,603,000: *Provided*, That such amount is designated
23 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
24 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
25 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided further*,

1 That the amount provided under this heading shall be
2 available only if the President designates such amount as
3 being for an emergency requirement pursuant to section
4 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

5 OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, MARINE CORPS

6 For an additional amount for “Operation and Main-
7 tenance, Marine Corps” for necessary expenses to respond
8 to the significant rise in unaccompanied minors and family
9 unit aliens at the southwest border and related activities,
10 \$13,025,000: *Provided*, That such amount is designated
11 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
12 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
13 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided further*,
14 That the amount provided under this heading shall be
15 available only if the President designates such amount as
16 being for an emergency requirement pursuant to section
17 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

18 OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, AIR FORCE

19 For an additional amount for “Operation and Main-
20 tenance, Air Force” for necessary expenses to respond to
21 the significant rise in unaccompanied minors and family
22 unit aliens at the southwest border and related activities,
23 \$35,372,000: *Provided*, That such amount is designated
24 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
25 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and

1 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided further*,
 2 That the amount provided under this heading shall be
 3 available only if the President designates such amount as
 4 being for an emergency requirement pursuant to section
 5 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

6 OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, ARMY NATIONAL GUARD

7 For an additional amount for “Operation and Main-
 8 tenance, Army National Guard” for necessary expenses to
 9 respond to the significant rise in unaccompanied minors
 10 and family unit aliens at the southwest border and related
 11 activities, \$21,024,000: *Provided*, That such amount is
 12 designated by the Congress as an emergency requirement
 13 pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budg-
 14 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided*
 15 *further*, That the amount provided under this heading
 16 shall be available only if the President designates such
 17 amount as being for an emergency requirement pursuant
 18 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

21 ADMINISTRATION FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

22 REFUGEE AND ENTRANT ASSISTANCE

23 For an additional amount for “Refugee and Entrant
 24 Assistance” \$2,881,552,000, to be merged with and avail-
 25 able for the same period as funds appropriated in Public

1 Law 115–245 for carrying out section 414 of the Immi-
 2 gration and Nationality Act, section 501 of the Refugee
 3 Education Assistance Act of 1980, section 462 of the
 4 Homeland Security Act of 2002, and section 235 of the
 5 William Wilberforce Trafficking Victims Protection Reau-
 6 thorization Act of 2008: *Provided*, That such amount is
 7 designated by the Congress as an emergency requirement
 8 pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budg-
 9 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided*
 10 *further*, That the amount provided under this heading
 11 shall be available only if the President designates such
 12 amount as being for an emergency requirement pursuant
 13 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

14 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY
 15 SECURITY, ENFORCEMENT, AND BORDER PROTECTION
 16 U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION
 17 OPERATIONS AND SUPPORT

18 For an additional amount for “Operations and Sup-
 19 port” for necessary expenses to respond to the significant
 20 rise in unaccompanied minors and family unit aliens at
 21 the southwest border and related activities, \$479,528,000;
 22 of which \$190,000,000 shall be available until September
 23 30, 2020: *Provided*, That such amount is designated by
 24 the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant to
 25 section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and

1 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided further*,
 2 That the amount provided under this heading shall be
 3 available only if the President designates such amount as
 4 being for an emergency requirement pursuant to section
 5 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

6 PROCUREMENT, CONSTRUCTION, AND IMPROVEMENTS

7 For an additional amount for “Procurement, Con-
 8 struction, and Improvements” for necessary expenses to
 9 respond to the significant rise in unaccompanied minors
 10 and family unit aliens at the southwest border and related
 11 activities, \$85,000,000, to remain available until Sep-
 12 tember 30, 2023: *Provided*, That such amount is des-
 13 ignated by the Congress as an emergency requirement
 14 pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budg-
 15 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided*
 16 *further*, That the amount provided under this heading
 17 shall be available only if the President designates such
 18 amount as being for an emergency requirement pursuant
 19 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

20 U.S. IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT

21 OPERATIONS AND SUPPORT

22 For an additional amount for “Operations and Sup-
 23 port” for necessary expenses to respond to the significant
 24 rise in unaccompanied minors and family unit aliens at
 25 the southwest border and related activities, and for the

1 necessary expenses for enforcement of immigration and
2 customs laws, detention and removal of aliens crossing the
3 border unlawfully, and investigations, \$534,566,000; of
4 which \$81,723,611 shall be available until September 30,
5 2020: *Provided*, That such amount is designated by the
6 Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant to sec-
7 tion 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
8 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided further*, That
9 the amount provided under this heading shall be available
10 only if the President designates such amount as being for
11 an emergency requirement pursuant to section
12 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

13 DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

14 UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE

15 FEDERAL PRISONER DETENTION

16 For an additional amount for “Federal Prisoner De-
17 tention”, \$155,000,000: *Provided*, That such amount is
18 designated by the Congress as an emergency requirement
19 pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budg-
20 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided*
21 *further*, That the amount provided under this heading
22 shall be available only if the President designates such
23 amount as being for an emergency requirement pursuant
24 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of such Act.

2 mental Appropriations Act, 2019”.
