 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Small Transit Commu-

5 nities Modernization Act".

6 SEC. 2. ELIGIBLE AREA.

7 Section 5336(i)(1)(A) of title 49, United States Code,

8 is amended to read as follows:

"(A) ELIGIBLE AREA.—

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2 "(i) IN GENERAL.—Except as pro-3 vided in clause (ii), the term 'eligible area' 4 means an urbanized area with a population 5 of less than 200,000 that meets or exceeds 6 in one or more performance categories the 7 industry average for all urbanized areas 8 with a population of at least 200,000 but 9 not more than 999,999, as determined by the Secretary in accordance with sub-10 11 section (c)(2).

"(ii) 12 EXCEPTION.—For anv fiscal 13 year beginning after the date of enactment 14 of the Small Transit Communities Mod-15 ernization Act through fiscal year 2030, 16 with respect to a transit agency that 17 served an urbanized area determined by 18 the 2010 census to have had a population 19 of less than 200,000, the term 'eligible 20 area' shall include an urbanized area 21 that-

22 "(I) was determined to be an ur23 banized area with a population of at
24 least 200,000 but not more than

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999,999, according to the most recent 1 2 decennial census; and 3 "(II) met or exceeded one or more of the performance categories 4 described in subparagraph (B) in each 5 of the 3 years prior to the year in 6 7 which the apportionment is provided.". 8

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
