

1	A PROPOSED RESOLUTION
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5	IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
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10	To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need
11	to amend the Condominium Warranty Act of 1976 to clarify the standards and procedures
12	governing the resolution of a claim for a condominium developer's warranty against
11 12 13 14	structural defects, that a claimant may appeal the findings of the Mayor to the Office of
14	Administrative Hearings, and the circumstances when the Mayor may release the
15	warranty security funds to a claimant.
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may

20	D. C. Official Code § 12-1903 .16) ("act"), established initial procedures for a declarant to

22	(b) The District of Columbia Department of Housing and Community Development has
23	been designated by the Mayor to administer the Condominium Act of 1976.
	been designated by the Mayor to definitister the Condominant Fet of 1570.
24	(c) The increased number of condominiums in the District has led to a sharp increase in
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25	the number of structural defect warranty claims without standards and procedures governing an
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26	adjudication process to resolve those claims.
27	(d) Therefore, there exists an immediate need to amend the act to establish a process to
_ /	(a) Therefore, there exists an infinediate need to amend the act to establish a process to
28	resolve warranty claims that arise under the act.

29	(e) On February 4, 2020, the Council passed the Condominium Warranty Claims
30	Clarification Emergency Amendment Act of 2020, effective February 27, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-
31	231; 67 DCR 2510), which expired on May 27, 2020.
32	(f) On March 3, 2020, the Council passed the Condominium Warranty Claims
33	Clarification Emergency Amendment Act of 2020, enacted on March 26, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-
34	273; 67 DCR 3938), which is projected to become law on June 8, 2020.
35	(g) In order to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency
36	legislation and the effective date of the temporary legislation, it is necessary to approve
37	congressional review emergency legislation.
38	Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
39	enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
40	Condominium Warranty Claims Clarification Congressional Review Emergency Amendment
41	Act of 2020 be adopted after a single reading.
42	Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately
