A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 15 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to miscellaneous provisions under the "Quality Basic Education Act,"
3 so as to provide for unique identifiers for students who are children of military personnel; to
4 provide a short title; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Educating Children of Military Families
9 Act."

10 **SECTION 2.**

11 Part 15 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
12 relating to miscellaneous provisions under the "Quality Basic Education Act," is amended
13 by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

14 "20-2-324.3.

15 The Department of Education is authorized to establish a unique identifier for each student:

16 (1) Whose parent or guardian is an active duty military service member in the armed
17 forces of the United States; and

18 (2) Whose parent is a member of a reserve component of the armed forces of the United
19 States or the National Guard

20 in a manner that will allow for disaggregation of data for each category."

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
