- 11 Department of Health shall report to the Senate Finance Committee, the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee, the House Health and Government Operations Committee, and 12

- Government Article, on: 14
- 15 (1) the revision of COMAR 10.63;
- 16 (2)improvements to the oversight of substance use disorder treatment 17 programs; and
- 18 (3)improvements to procedures for the certification, monitoring, and 19 oversight of recovery residences.

(b) The reports required under subsection (a) of this section shall include, to the extent authorized by law, an analysis of how the revisions to COMAR 10.63 and other changes undertaken by the Department will prevent events similar to those that occurred and were reported related to PHA Healthcare, including patient relapse and death while enrolled in a substance use disorder program and housed in provider—owned buildings.
