A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 14 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to other educational programs under the "Quality Basic Education Act,"
- 3 so as to require a local school system to allow home study students to participate in
- 4 extracurricular and interscholastic activities; to provide for definitions; to provide that home
- 5 study students are subject to all rules, regulations, and codes of conduct as would apply to
- 6 other students; to provide for rules and regulations by the State Board of Education; to
- 7 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Part 14 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- relating to other educational programs under the "Quality Basic Education Act," is amended
- 12 by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 13 "<u>20-2-319.5.</u>
- 14 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 15 (1) 'Extracurricular and interscholastic activities' means special interest groups and clubs,
- interscholastic and intramural athletics, academic competitions, exhibitions, and fine arts
- 17 <u>programs conducted outside of the regular school day but does not include cocurricular</u>
- activities, which require enrollment in a corresponding class.
- 19 (2) 'Home study student' means a student in a home study program which meets the
- 20 requirements of subsection (c) of Code Section 20-2-690.
- 21 (3) 'Resident school' means the public school in the local school system in which such
- student would be enrolled by virtue of his or her residence.
- 23 (b) A local school system shall allow home study students to participate in any
- 24 <u>extracurricular and interscholastic activities offered or conducted by his or her resident</u>
- 25 <u>school in the same manner as any public school student attending such resident school.</u> A

home study student shall be required to complete any related forms required by the local
 school system or pursuant to State Board of Education rules.

- 28 (c) A home study student shall be required to comply with and shall be subject to the same
- 29 rules and requirements for participation that apply to any public school student's
- 30 participation in extracurricular and interscholastic activities and shall be subject to the same
- 31 code of conduct as would apply to other students participating in the same activity.
- 32 (d) The State Board of Education shall establish rules and regulations to facilitate the
- 33 provisions of this Code section."

34 SECTION 2.

35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
