A BILL

To permit aliens seeking asylum to be eligible for employment in the United States, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Asylum Seeker Work
- 5 Authorization Act of 2023".
- 6 SEC. 2. EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION FOR ALIENS SEEK-
- 7 ING ASYLUM.
- 8 Paragraph (2) of section 208(d) of the Immigration
- 9 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1158(d)) is amended to
- 10 read as follows:

1	"(2) Employment authorization.—
2	"(A) Eligibility.—The Secretary of
3	Homeland Security shall authorize employment
4	for an applicant for asylum who is not in deten-
5	tion and whose application for asylum has not
6	been determined frivolous.
7	"(B) APPLICATION.—An applicant for asy-
8	lum who is not otherwise eligible for employ-
9	ment authorization shall not be granted such
10	authorization prior to 30 days after the date of
11	filing of the application for asylum.
12	"(C) Term.—Employment authorization
13	for an applicant for asylum shall be valid until
14	the date on which an applicant is issued a final
15	denial of the applicable application, including
