"(3) Beginning with those students receiving a HOPE scholarship for the first time on or after July 1, 2018, seven 15 years from a student's graduation from high school or the equivalent thereof as determined by the Georgia Student Finance Commission in its rules and regulations; provided, however, that for a student who serves in the military during such seven-year 15 year period, any such active duty military service served as active duty shall not count against the seven-year 15 year period nor constitute a failure to be enrolled. A student that is ineligible to receive a HOPE scholarship pursuant to this paragraph but who received the HOPE scholarship during the 2010-2011 academic year shall continue to be eligible for the HOPE scholarship until June 30, 2015, as long as such student meets all other eligibility requirements, including, but not limited to, paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subsection. Any student enrolled full-time or part-time in a college or university eligible for HOPE scholarship under the provisions of this paragraph as long as such student meets all other eligibility requirements, including, but not limited to, the requirements provided for in paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subsection."
