A BILL

To enact section 4303.2011 of the Revised Code to
create the F-11 liquor permit, which authorizes
specified entities to sell beer and wine at
special functions, including social and
benevolent functions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4303.2011 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 4303.2011. (A) As used in this section:

(1) "Organization" means an association or employer of ten
or more persons, a labor union, or a charitable organization.

(2) "Special function" means a function that has a social,
recreational, benevolent, charitable, fraternal, political,
patriotic, or athletic purpose. "Special function" does not
include any function the proceeds of which are for the profit or
gain of any individual.

(B) Permit F-11 may be issued to an organization to do
both of the following:

(1) Purchase beer from holders of A-1, A-1c, and B-1 18
permits and to sell the beer at special functions held during 19
the validity period of the F-11 permit; 20

(2) Purchase wine from holders of A-2, A-2f, B-2, and B-5 21
permits and to sell the wine at special functions held during 22
the validity period of the F-11 permit. 23

An F-11 permit is valid for thirty days. Not more than 24
three F-11 permits may be issued to the same applicant in any 25
one-year period. 26

(C) The fee for the F-11 permit is one hundred fifty 27
dollars. 28
