## AN ACT

To authorize the Every Word We Utter Monument to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

(a) IN GENERAL.—The Every Word We Utter Monument may establish a commemorative work on Federal
land in the District of Columbia and its environs to commemorate the women's suffrage movement and the passage of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution, which
gave women the right to vote.

9 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-10 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the commemora-11 tive work under this section shall be in accordance with 12 chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (commonly 13 known as the "Commemorative Works Act").

14 (c) PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL15 FUNDS.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—Federal funds may not be
17 used to pay any expense of the establishment of the
18 commemorative work under this section.

(2) RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EVERY WORD WE
UTTER MONUMENT.—The Every Word We Utter
Monument shall be solely responsible for acceptance
of contributions for, and payment of the expenses of,
the establishment of the commemorative work under
this section.

25 (d) Deposit of Excess Funds.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—If upon payment of all ex-1 2 penses for the establishment of the memorial (in-3 cluding the maintenance and preservation amount 4 required by section 8906(b)(1) of title 40, United 5 States Code), there remains a balance of funds re-6 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative 7 work, the Every Word We Utter Monument shall 8 transmit the amount of the balance to the Secretary 9 of the Interior for deposit in the account provided 10 for in section 8906(b)(3) of title 40, United States 11 Code.

12 (2) ON EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY.—If upon 13 expiration of the authority for the commemorative 14 work under section 8903(e) of title 40, United 15 States Code, there remains a balance of funds received for the establishment of the commemorative 16 17 work, the Every Word We Utter Monument shall 18 transmit the amount of the balance to a separate ac-19 count with the National Park Foundation for memo-20 rials, to be available to the Secretary of the Interior 21 or Administrator (as appropriate) following the proc-22 ess provided in section 8906(b)(4) of title 40, United 23 States Code, for accounts established under 24 8906(b)(2) or (3) of title 40, United States Code.

## 1 SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

2 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of 3 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010, 4 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this 5 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record 6 7 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, provided that such statement has been submitted prior to the 8 vote on passage. 9
