## A BILL

To amend the Grand Ronde Reservation Act, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. GRAND RONDE RESERVATION ACT AMEND-
- 4 MENT.
- 5 Section 1(d) of Public Law 100–425 (commonly
- 6 known as the "Grand Ronde Reservation Act") (102 Stat.
- 7 1594) is amended—
- 8 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking "lands within
- 9 the State of Oregon" and inserting "the 84 acres
- 10 known as the Thompson Strip";

1	(2) by redesignating paragraph (2) as para-
2	graph (4); and
3	(3) by inserting after paragraph (1) the fol-
4	lowing:
5	"(2) Gaming Prohibition.—Any real property
6	transferred to the Tribes as part of a land claim set-
7	tlement approved by the United States shall not be
8	eligible, or used, for any class II gaming or class III
9	gaming (as those terms are defined in section 4 of
10	the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act (25 U.S.C.
11	2703)).".
12	SEC. 2. TREATY RIGHTS OF FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED
13	TRIBES.
14	Nothing in this Act, or the amendments made by this
15	Act, shall be construed to enlarge, confirm, adjudicate, af-
16	fect, or modify any treaty right of an Indian tribe (as de-
17	fined in section 4 of the Indian Self-Determination and
18	Education Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 5304))
