2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cane River Creole Na-
5 tional Historical Park Boundary Modification Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CANE RIVER CREOLE NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK**
2 **BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.**

3 Section 303(b) of the Cane River Creole National
4 Historical Park and National Heritage Area Act (16
5 U.S.C. 410ccc–1(b)) is amended by adding at the end the
6 following:

7 ~~“(5) The approximately 46.1 acres of land de-~~
8 ~~scribed as tracts 1, 2, and 3 on the map entitled ‘A~~
9 ~~Map of Lands in Sections 111, 112 & 113, T7N-~~
10 ~~R6W’ and dated May 20, 2021 (referred to in this~~
11 ~~paragraph as the ‘Map’), subject to the requirement~~
12 ~~that, as soon as practicable after the date of enact-~~
13 ~~ment of this paragraph, the Secretary shall prepare~~
14 ~~a map of the tracts consistent with National Park~~
15 ~~Service standards to replace the Map.~~

17 *tified as ‘Proposed Addition’, as generally depicted on*
18 *the map entitled ‘Cane River Creole National Histor-*
19 *ical Park Proposed Addition—Magnolia Plantation*
