## **ADOPTED**

Representative Petrea of the 166<sup>th</sup> offers the following amendment:

- Amend the Senate substitute to HB 452 (HB 452/SCSFA) by replacing lines 5 through 10
- 2 with the following:
- 3 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
- 4 By replacing lines 12 through 727 with the following:
- 5 SECTION 1.
- Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to law enforcement officers and
- 7 agencies, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 8 "35-3-14.
- 9 To the extent permitted by federal law, the bureau shall post on its public website the information of persons who are aliens and who have been released from federal custody 10 within the boundaries of this state, as such information is presented within the Law 11 12 Enforcement Notification System of the Enforcement Integrated Database of the United 13 States Department of Homeland Security or the National Law Enforcement 14 Telecommunications System as received by the Georgia Information Sharing and Analysis Center within the bureau or any replacement agency. Within 12 hours of receiving such 15 16 information, the bureau shall post such information as required by this Code section and 17 electronically send a copy of such information to the Georgia Sheriffs' Association. The
- bureau shall promulgate rules and regulations for the implementation of this Code section."
- 19 SECTION 2.
- All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
