A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Health – Maryland Children's Service Animal Program – Establishment

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Children's Service Animal Program in the Maryland Department of Health; specifying the purposes of the Program; requiring 4 $\mathbf{5}$ the Department to select at least one nonprofit entity to implement a certain training 6 protocol, select certain Program participants, certain dogs, or therapy horses, 7 facilitate certain training or therapy, and partner certain participants with certain 8 dogs except under certain circumstances; establishing certain criteria that a 9 nonprofit entity must meet to be eligible for selection under the Program; authorizing a nonprofit training entity, under certain circumstances, to disgualify a Program 10 11 participant from participating in the Program; authorizing a Program participant to 12discontinue involvement in the Program for any reason; establishing the Maryland 13 Children's Service Animal Program Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; requiring 14the Department to use certain revenue from the Fund to pay a nonprofit training 15entity; requiring the Secretary of Health to administer the Fund; requiring the State 16 Treasurer to hold the Fund and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying 17the contents of the Fund; specifying the purposes for which the Fund may be used; 18 providing for the investment of money in and expenditures from the Fund; requiring 19the Department to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; requiring the 20Department, on or before a certain date, to report certain information to the General 21Assembly; and generally relating to the Maryland Children's Service Animal 22Program.

3 (B) THE PURPOSES OF THE PROGRAM ARE TO:

4 (1) REFER ELIGIBLE CHILDREN WHO MAY BENEFIT FROM 5 PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM TO ONE OR MORE NONPROFIT TRAINING 6 ENTITIES;

7 (2) PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING MECHANISMS TO ASSIST 8 CHILDREN PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM; AND

9 (3) EXPAND TREATMENT OF CHILDREN WITH A HISTORY OF TRAUMA 10 OR POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER.
