6	6(o) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C.
7	2015(o)) is amended by striking paragraph (4).
8	(b) Conforming Regulatory Change.—Not later
9	than 30 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,
10	the Secretary of Agriculture shall implement the amend-
11	ment made by subsection (a) by revising section 273.24
12	of title 7, Code of Federal Regulations, to remove sub-
13	section (f).
