A BILL

To require air carriers receiving Federal loans under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act to limit compensation paid to each executive to the amount of such executive's 2019 salary until such loans are repaid, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Taxpayer Account-
- 5 ability for Airlines Relief Act".

SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON COMPENSATION TO AIR CARRIER

- 2 **EXECUTIVES.**
- 3 (a) In General.—With respect to an air carrier re-
- 4 ceiving a Federal loan under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief,
- 5 and Economic Security Act, until such time as the air car-
- 6 rier repays all of such loan, the air carrier may only pay
- 7 compensation to an executive of the air carrier in an
- 8 amount equal to or less than the amount of salary paid
- 9 to the executive in 2019.
- 10 (b) Definitions.—In this section:
- 11 (1) AIR CARRIER.—The term "air carrier" has 12 the meaning such term has under section 40102 of
- title 49, United States Code.
- 14 (2) EXECUTIVE.—With respect to an air car-
- rier, the term "executive" means an employee of the
- air carrier whose total compensation exceeded
- 17 \$425,000 in calendar year 2019. For purposes of
- this paragraph, for an employee hired after January
- 19 1, 2019, the annualized salary of such employee for
- calendar year 2019 shall be used instead of the ac-
- tual salary of the employee.
