## A BILL

- To authorize Department of Veterans Affairs health care providers to provide recommendations and opinions to veterans regarding participation in State marijuana programs.

  - **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Equal Access5 Act".

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi7 sion of law, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall author8 ize physicians and other health care providers employed
9 by the Department of Veterans Affairs to—

(1) provide recommendations and opinions to
veterans who are residents of States with State
marijuana programs regarding the participation of
veterans in such State marijuana programs; and

14 (2) complete forms reflecting such recommenda-15 tions and opinions.

16 (b) STATE DEFINED.—In this section, the term 17 "State" means each of the several States, the District of 18 Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, any terri-19 tory or possession of the United States, and each federally 20 recognized Indian Tribe.
