27	(1) A person with a permit of any kind to carry a concealed firearm may not carry a
28	concealed firearm in the following locations:
29	(a) any secure area prescribed in Section 76-10-523.5 in which firearms are prohibited
30	and notice of the prohibition posted;
31	(b) any airport secure area as provided in Section 76-10-529; or
32	(c) any house of worship or in any private residence where dangerous weapons are
33	prohibited as provided in Section 76-10-530.
