- 18 Leadership Georgia awarded him the 2015 J.W. Fanning Award; and
- 19 WHEREAS, thanks to his integrity, vision, and determination, Hank Huckaby's decades of
- 20 public service have made Georgia a better place, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that
- 21 the outstanding accomplishments of this remarkable and distinguished Georgian be
- 22 appropriately recognized.
