3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Provide Accurate In-

5 formation Directly Act" or "PAID Act".

6 SEC. 2. TRANSPARENCY OF MEDICARE SECONDARY PAYER 7 REPORTING INFORMATION.

8 Section 1862(b)(8)(G) of the Social Security Act (42)

9 U.S.C. 395y(b)(8)(G)) is amended—

1	(1) by striking "INFORMATION.—The Sec-
2	retary" and inserting "INFORMATION.—
3	"(i) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary";
4	and
5	(2) by adding at the end the following new
6	clause:
7	"(ii) Specified information.—In
8	responding to any query related to sub-
9	paragraph (A)(i), the Secretary, notwith-
10	standing any other provision of law,
11	shall—
12	"(I) identify to the applicable
13	plan whether a claimant subject to the
14	query is, or during the preceding 3-
15	year period has been, entitled to bene-
16	fits under the program under this title
17	on any basis; and
18	"(II) to the extent applicable,
19	identify by plan name and address
20	any Medicare Advantage plan under
21	part C and any prescription drug plan
22	under part D in which the claimant is
23	enrolled or has been enrolled during
24	such period.".

1 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 The amendments made by section 2 shall apply with3 respect to queries submitted on or after the date that is4 one year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
