A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize and extend funding for community health centers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Community Health In-
5 vestment, Modernization, and Excellence Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY HEALTH**
7 **CENTERS.**

8 Paragraph (1) of section 10503(b) of the Patient
9 Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 254b-
10 2(b)) is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (D), by striking “and” at
2 the end;

3 (2) in subparagraph (E), by striking
4 “\$3,600,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2015
5 through 2017; and” and inserting “\$3,600,000,000
6 for each of fiscal years 2015 through 2018;”; and

7 (3) by adding at the end the following:

8 “(F) for fiscal year 2019, \$3,800,000,000;

9 “(G) for fiscal year 2020, \$4,000,000,000;

10 “(H) for fiscal year 2021, \$4,200,000,000;

11 and

12 “(I) for fiscal year 2022,

13 \$4,400,000,000.”.
