Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Barbershop and Beauty Salon License

- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing a barbershop and beauty salon beer and wine license in $\mathbf{5}$ Anne Arundel County; specifying the individuals who are qualified to hold the 6 license; authorizing a license holder to serve a certain amount of beer or wine by the 7 glass to a customer for on-premises consumption under certain circumstances; 8 specifying the hours during which a license holder is authorized to serve beer and 9 wine; stating that a license holder need not obtain a certain Sunday license; 10 establishing an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in 11 Anne Arundel County.

4 (E) A LICENSE HOLDER NEED NOT OBTAIN A SUNDAY LICENSE UNDER 5 § 11–2004 OF THIS TITLE TO PROVIDE BEER AND WINE ON SUNDAY.

6 (F) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$100.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
1, 2020.
