Move over requirement.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the regulation of traffic on highways;  
2 creating requirements for passing parked vehicles as  
3 specified; amending provisions relating to the use of  
4 flashing lights on vehicles; and providing for an effective  
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-238 is created to read:

10

11 **31-5-238. Operation of vehicles upon approach of**  
12 **stopped vehicles using flashing lights.**

13

14 (a) When a parked municipal, county, public service  
15 corporation, highway construction or highway maintenance

1 vehicle is making use of any visual signals provided for in  
2 W.S. 31-5-928(f)(ii) or 31-5-930 or any parked vehicle is  
3 making use of flashing lights as provided for in W.S.  
4 31-5-915, 31-5-923 or 31-5-931(b), the driver of every  
5 other vehicle, as soon as it is safe:

6  
7 (i) When driving on an interstate highway or  
8 other highway with two (2) or more lanes traveling in the  
9 direction of the parked vehicle shall merge into the lane  
10 farthest from the vehicle, except when otherwise directed  
11 by a police officer;

12  
13 (ii) When driving on a two (2) lane road, shall  
14 slow to a speed that is twenty (20) miles per hour less  
15 than the posted speed limit, except when otherwise directed  
16 by a police officer.

17  
18 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-5-928(c) and (f)(ii) is amended to  
19 read:

20  
21 **31-5-928. General lighting restrictions; authorized**  
22 **emergency vehicles.**

1 (c) Flashing lights are prohibited except as  
2 authorized by W.S. 31-5-915, 31-5-921, 31-5-923, 31-5-929,  
3 31-5-930, 31-5-931 and this section.

5 (f) The following vehicles are authorized to display  
6 flashing white and amber lights in addition to those  
7 otherwise authorized by law:

8

9 (ii) Vehicles of municipalities, counties and  
10 public service corporations;

12           **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
