Mr. Sullivan introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Appropriations

## A BILL

Making continuing appropriations for military pay in the event of a Government shutdown.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Pay Our Military Act
- 5 of 2023".
- 6 SEC. 2. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF
- 7 THE ARMED FORCES.
- 8 (a) In General.—There are hereby appropriated for
- 9 fiscal year 2024, out of any money in the Treasury not
- 10 otherwise appropriated, for any period during which in-

- 1 terim or full-year appropriations for fiscal year 2024 are
- 2 not in effect—
- (1) such sums as are necessary to provide pay and allowances to members of the Armed Forces (as defined in section 101(a)(4) of title 10, United States Code), including reserve components thereof, who perform active service during such period;
- 9 and allowances to the civilian personnel of the De10 partment of Defense (and the Department of Home11 land Security in the case of the Coast Guard) whom
  12 the Secretary concerned determines are providing
  13 support to members of the Armed Forces described
  14 in paragraph (1); and
  - (3) such sums as are necessary to provide pay and allowances to contractors of the Department of Defense (and the Department of Homeland Security in the case of the Coast Guard) whom the Secretary concerned determines are providing support to members of the Armed Forces described in paragraph (1).
- (b) SECRETARY CONCERNED DEFINED.—In this sec-tion, the term "Secretary concerned" means—
- 24 (1) the Secretary of Defense with respect to 25 matters concerning the Department of Defense; and

3	SEC. 3. TERMINATION.
4	Appropriations and funds made available and author-
5	ity granted pursuant to this Act shall be available until
6	whichever of the following first occurs:
7	(1) The enactment into law of an appropriation
8	(including a continuing appropriation) for any pur-
9	pose for which amounts are made available in sec-
10	tion 2.
11	(2) The enactment into law of the applicable
12	regular or continuing appropriations resolution or
13	other Act without any appropriation for such pur-
14	pose.
15	(3) January 1, 2025.
