## **A BILL**

To amend the Federal Power Act to provide that any inaction by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission that allows a rate change to go into effect shall be treated as an order by the Commission for purposes of rehearing and court review.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fair Ratepayer Ac-
- 5 countability, Transparency, and Efficiency Standards
- 6 Act" or the "Fair RATES Act".

### 1 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE FEDERAL POWER ACT.

- 2 Section 205(d) of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
- 3 824d(d)) is amended by adding at the end the following:
- 4 "Any absence of action by the Commission that allows a
- 5 change to take effect under this section (including the
- 6 Commission allowing the 60 days of notice provided under
- 7 this section to expire without Commission action) shall be
- 8 considered to be an order issued by the Commission ac-
- 9 cepting the change for purposes of section 313.".

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
