2 Health Insurance - Audits of Claims by Pharmacies or Pharmacists - Deadlines

- FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain carrier, if the carrier conducts a certain audit of a claim by a pharmacy or pharmacist, to audit only claims submitted or adjudicated within a certain period of time immediately preceding the audit except under certain circumstances; altering the time frame during which certain claims must be submitted or adjudicated for the claims to be audited by a pharmacy benefits manager; defining a certain term; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to audits of claims by pharmacies or pharmacists.
