## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 6, 2018, as Hemophilia of Georgia Day at the state capitol; and for other

2 purposes.

WHEREAS, each year, thousands of Americans, including Georgians, are impacted byhemophilia and other bleeding disorders; and

5 WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia, a nonprofit organization based in Sandy Springs, is 6 dedicated to providing services and support to Georgians who have hemophilia, von

7 Willebrand Disease, and other inherited bleeding disorders; and

8 WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia's mission for more than 40 years has been to "exist so 9 that people affected by bleeding disorders live as normally and productively as possible"; and

10 WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia is the only organization in Georgia offering services to

11 these individuals so as to enhance their care and quality of life; and

12 WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia employs pharmacists, nurses, social workers, and others

13 to carry out the organization's work and mission; and

14 WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia operates successful pharmacies which have received

15 accreditation from the Accreditation Commission for Health Care, Inc., demonstrating a

16 commitment to high-quality standards of care; and

WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia provides these Georgians with various pharmaceutical
services for those with bleeding disorders, including blood clotting factor products, home

19 infusion training, education, and other resources; and

- 20 WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia specifically provides children with these disorders the
- ability to attend summer camp at Camp Wannaklot; publishes *Horizons in Hemophilia*, the

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22 award-winning newsletter for clients and their families to stay up to date with advances in

23 treatment; produces *Protocols for the Treatment of Hemophilia and von Willebrand Disease* 

24 for physicians and other health care providers; offers financial support for hemophilia

- 25 treatment centers throughout Georgia to ensure that the treatment centers are fully staffed and
- 26 equipped; and invests in critical research for these bleeding disorders and their associated
- 27 complications; and

28 WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia serves on the state's Georgia Hemophilia Advisory

29 Board as an advisor on the standards of care and treatment for individuals with hemophilia

30 and other bleeding disorders; and

WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia rigorously pursues funding to find a cure for these disorders and ways to fund the care for those who cannot pay for the necessary medical assistance and pharmaceuticals required to treat or prevent a bleeding episode; and

34 WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia continues to provide funding to St. Jude Children's

35 Research Hospital and the Aflac Cancer and Blood Disorders Center at Emory University

36 for clinical trials to find a cure for hemophilia; and

WHEREAS, Hemophilia of Georgia serves as a trusted resource to many health care providers and insurers by providing each with training on bleeding disorders, including appropriate care and treatment, and the organization is recognized nationally and internationally for its work; and

WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding contributions of thisextraordinary organization be appropriately recognized.

43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that the members of this body recognize March 6, 2018, as Hemophilia of Georgia Day at the 44 state capitol; commend Hemophilia of Georgia, its staff and volunteers, and the persons that 45 the organization serves and their past, present, and future work on behalf of those individuals 46 47 suffering from hemophilia and other bleeding disorders in this state, throughout the nation, and around the world; and encourage all citizens to support Hemophilia of Georgia's efforts 48 49 to fund initiatives and programs to help those individuals with hemophilia and bleeding 50 disorders.
