SEC. 2. EXCEPTION FOR FAILURE TO DELIVER GOODS OR COMPLETE WORK DUE TO LAPSE IN APPROPRIATIONS.
(a) In General.-Section 1126 of title 41, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following:
"(c) Exception for Failure To Deliver Goods or Complete Work Due to Lapse in Approprla-TIONS.-If the head of an executive agency determines that a contractor failed by reason of a lapse in appropriations in the Federal Government to deliver goods or complete work under a contract with the agency by the date or within the time period imposed by the contract any information relating to such failure may not be-
"(1) included in any past performance database used by executive agencies for making source selection decisions; or
"(2) evaluated unfavorably on the factor of past contract performance.".
