27	Code of Alabama 1975.

1 (b) If a child enrolled at a day care center has not 2 arrived at the center by 9:30 a.m., and has not been reported 3 as being absent for that day by his or her parent or guardian 4 by that time, the center shall immediately place a phone call 5 to the parent or guardian to ask whether the child will be 6 absent from the center that day.

Section 3. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
