3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Know Your Vets Act".

5 SEC. 2. INFORMATION REGARDING COUNTY VETERANS 6 SERVICE OFFICERS.

7 (a) PROVISION OF INFORMATION.—The Secretary of
8 Defense shall ensure that a member of the Armed Forces
9 who is separating or retiring from the Armed Forces may

elect to have the Department of Defense form DD-214
 of the member transmitted to the appropriate county vet erans service officer based on the mailing address provided
 by the member.

5 (b) DATABASE.—The Secretary of Defense, in coordi6 nation with the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, shall main7 tain a database of all county veterans service officers.

8 (c) COUNTY VETERANS SERVICE OFFICER DE-9 FINED.—In this section, the term "county veterans service 10 officer" means an employee of a county government, local 11 government, or Tribal government who is covered by sec-12 tion 14.629(a)(2) of title 38, Code of Federal Regulations.
