A BILL

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IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

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To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 7, 9, and 10 of Option Year Two to Contract No. RM-17-C-032-BY4-JM with MBI Health Services, LLC to provide community wraparound services for up to 94 youths and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. RM-17-C-032-BY4-JM with MBI Health Services, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2019”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 7, 9, and 10 to Contract No. RM-17-C-032-BY4-JM with MBI Health Services, LLC to provide community wraparound services for up to 94 youths and authorizes payment in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1,091,597 for goods and services received and to be received under option year two of Contract No. RM-17-C-032-BY4-JM.

(C) **The goods or services to be provided, the methods of delivering goods or services, and any significant program changes reflected in the proposed contract:**

The Government of the District of Columbia, Department of Behavioral Health (DBH) is responsible for the majority of service provision to Clients of the District's Child Welfare System. Implementation of the Wraparound process has resulted in a fundamental shift in the way the District delivers services to children/youth experiencing intense behavioral health disorders to

include supports for their families. Instead of relying on Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTF), the Wraparound Services process has helped shape the District's capacity to provide Home and Community-based services. The presence of Wraparound Services and the increase in Evidenced Based Services has allowed the District to experience a decrease in the utilization of Residential Treatment and Services.

MBI Health Services, LLC shall utilize the Wraparound Services process as defined by the National Wraparound Initiative standards for delivering within the Community for referred children demonstrating intensive and complex behavioral health needs. This assures a unique, individualized set of community services and natural supports wrapped around the Child and Family to achieve desired outcomes. Consistent with the Wraparound Services philosophy, MBI Health Services, LLC shall ensure that all Care Coordinators hired shall be trained in the Wraparound Services process.

**(D) The selection process, including the number of offerors, the evaluation criteria, and the evaluation results, including price, technical or quality, and past performance components:**

Source Selection was based on lowest Bidder that was responsible and responsive to the Solicitation Requirements.

On January 2, 2017, The Office of Contracting and Procurement (OCP) on behalf of the Department of Behavioral Health advertised the Invitation for Bid (IFB) for Community and School High Fidelity Wraparound Services in the Washington Time Newspaper. The Solicitation was issued in the Open Market with a 12% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Subcontract Requirement. On December 29, 2016, OCP received from the Director of Department of Small and Local Business Development (DSLBD) a waiver that reduced the 35% Subcontracting Requirement to 12% on the Community and School High Fidelity Wraparound Services' Solicitation. An Optional Pre-Bid Conference was held on January 12, 2017 at 12:00 Noon. There were three (3) amendments to this IFB Solicitation. Amendment one (1) issued on January 5, 2017 extended the closing date to February 1, 2017 and included an Optional Pre-Bid Conference. Amendment two (2) issued on January 11, 2017 revised the schedule B.3 – Price Schedule and Section C – Scope of Work by removing School High Fidelity Wraparound Services Requirement from the Solicitation. Amendment three (3) issued on January 26, 2017 extended the closing date to February 3, 2017 at 2:00 PM.

Seven (7) Prospective Bidders responded to the IFB and they were evaluated based on their Price and responsiveness to the Solicitation Requirements. MBI Health Services, LLC was the lowest price, responsive and responsible bidder to the Solicitation Requirements.

**(F) The background and qualifications of the proposed contractor, including its organization, financial stability, personnel, and performance on past or current government or private sector contracts with requirements similar to those of the proposed contract:**

MBI Health Services, LLC is a District of Columbia Limited Liability Company with headquarters at 4017 Minnesota Avenue, NE, Washington, DC. MBI, LLC offers a variety of healthcare and healthcare-related programs such as 1) A Free-Standing Mental Health Clinic, pursuant to the DC Department of Behavioral Health Certification; 2) A Mental Health Rehabilitation Services program, pursuant to DC Department of Behavioral Health Certification; 3) A Developmental Disabilities Program through certification from the DC Department on Disabilities Services.

MBI Health Services, LLC is also engaged in a Multi-Year Patient Escort and Messenger Support Services Contract at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) Clinical Center.

MBI Health Services, LLC professionals are carefully selected based on their education, credentials, proven experience, ability, capability, recommendations, professional and ethical conduct and personal demeanor.

MBI Health Services, LLC collaborates with other providers to provide comprehensive services to fill identified gaps in service availability and delivery to residents of the Washington, DC Metropolitan Area.

MBI Health Services, LLC offers a holistic approach to patient care by providing a comprehensive health care services.

MBI Health Services, LLC was recognized and certified in 2015 by Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services as one of the modern home-healthcare agencies which are scientifically measured and assessed to have high-quality home-health care services from promoting health and improving the quality of life.

The proposed change is being requested to allow for the continuation of contractual services under the option period while the procurement undergoes approval to exceed one million dollars.

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
