- Sec. 44.12.153. Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month. The
 month of May each year is established as Asian American and Pacific Islander
 Heritage Month. Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month may be
 observed by schools, community groups, and other public and private agencies and
 individuals with appropriate activities to honor and recognize the contributions made
 by Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders in the history of this state and the United
 States.
