BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5534.401 and 5534.402 of the
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 5534.401. That portion of the road known as state
route number sixty, running in a northerly and southerly
direction between the intersection of that route and county road
number ninety-seven in Muskingum county and the boundary of
Muskingum and Morgan counties, shall be known as "Lieutenant
Michael J. Lutz Memorial Highway."

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers

Sec. 5534.402. That portion of the road known as state

route number one hundred forty-six, running in a northwesterly 19
and southeasterly direction between the intersection of that 20
route and Musselman drive and the intersection of state route 21
number one hundred forty-six and Shannon valley road, in 22
Muskingum county, shall be known as "Deputy Sheriff Robert M. 23
Tanner, Jr. Memorial Highway." 24
