

3 4 5	(i) The State Board promptly shall hold a hearing, but a hearing may not be set within 10 days after the State Board sends the State Superintendent a notice of the hearing; and
6 7 8	(ii) The State Superintendent shall have an opportunity to be heard publicly before the State Board in the Superintendent's own defense, in person or by counsel.
9 10	(e) The State Board shall appoint a new State Superintendent to fill a vacancy in that office for the remainder of the unexpired term.
11 12	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July $1, 2020$.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
