1	AN ACT relating to veterans.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 40 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) The Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame is hereby created and shall be attached to
6	the Kentucky Department of Veterans' Affairs for administrative purposes. The
7	Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame shall recognize the active military and post-
8	military achievements of outstanding veterans and spotlight all veterans'
9	contributions to the civilian workplace.
10	(2) Each year, every person inducted into the Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame
11	during that year shall have his or her name placed on a plaque which shall be
12	prominently displayed in the State Capitol.
13	(3) The Department of Veterans' Affairs may promulgate administrative regulations
14	to carry out the provisions of Sections 1 to 3 of this Act.
15	→SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 40 IS CREATED TO
16	READ AS FOLLOWS:
17	(1) The Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame executive committee is hereby created for
18	the purpose of establishing specific time periods for the acceptance of
19	nominations and for the process of selecting nominees. The executive committee
20	shall be composed of twelve (12) members. Executive committee members shall
21	<u>be:</u>
22	(a) The commissioner of the Kentucky Department of Veterans' Affairs or his
23	or her designee;
24	(b) Two (2) members appointed by the commissioner of the Kentucky
25	Department of Veterans' Affairs, one (1) to represent the state veterans'
26	cemeteries and one (1) to represent the state veterans' nursing homes;
27	(c) The commander of Fort Knox or his or her designee;

I		(d) The commander of Fort Campbell or his or her designee;
2		(e) The Joint Executive Council of Veterans' Organizations of Kentucky, the
3		Kentucky State Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Kentucky American Legion,
4		the Disabled American Veterans Department of Kentucky, the AMVETS of
5		Kentucky, and the Vietnam Veterans of Kentucky shall each submit a list of
6		three (3) names to the Governor. The Governor shall appoint one (1)
7		member from each list; and
8		(f) One (1) member appointed by the Governor from a list of three (3) persons
9		submitted by the Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame Foundation.
10	<u>(2)</u>	The initial term of office for members of the Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame
11		executive committee shall be staggered so that members representing the state
12		veterans' cemeteries, the Joint Executive Council of Veterans' Organizations of
13		Kentucky, the Kentucky State Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Disabled American
14		Veterans Department of Kentucky, and the Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame
15		Foundation serve for two (2) years, and all other members serve for three (3)
16		years. All subsequent terms shall be for three (3) years. Each member shall serve
17		subsequent to the expiration of the member's term until the member's successor
18		is appointed, or until sixty (60) days have elapsed, whichever occurs first. No
19		members other than those appointed by the Kentucky Department of Veterans'
20		Affairs shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms.
21	<u>(3)</u>	All vacancies in the membership of the Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame
22		executive committee shall be filled in the same manner as prescribed for original
23		appointments, and the terms of the appointees shall be limited to the unexpired
24		<u>terms.</u>
25	<u>(4)</u>	The members of the Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame executive committee shall
26		serve without compensation.
27	(5)	The Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame executive committee shall elect a chair and

1	vice chair from its membership. It shall meet annually to select inductees for the
2	Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame from the persons nominated in a manner
3	prescribed by the executive committee. The names of selected inductees shall be
4	submitted to the Governor for final approval of the selected inductees. The
5	Governor shall provide any final approval within thirty (30) days after the
6	executive committee submits the names of the selected inductees. The Governor
7	may reject any of the selected inductees for cause, but shall not make any
8	additions to the list of those inductees.
9	→SECTION 3. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 40 IS CREATED TO
10	READ AS FOLLOWS:
l 1	(1) Nominations for the Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame may be accepted for any
12	person who:
13	(a) Has served in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States for a
14	period of longer than three (3) months, to include members of a state
15	National Guard who have served in federal active duty under Title 10 or
16	Title 32 of the United States Code, and was released, separated, discharged
17	or retired therefrom under honorable or general conditions;
18	(b) Was born in the state or has lived in the state for a period of five (5) or more
19	<u>years;</u>
20	(c) Is of good moral character; and
21	(d) Has not been convicted of any felony.
22	(2) All veterans who are recipients of the Medal of Honor or who were elected
23	President of the United States while residing in Kentucky and meet the
24	qualifications established in subsection (1) of this section shall be automatically
25	inducted into the Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame.
26	(3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, all state elected officials
27	members of the General Assembly, members of the Kentucky Veterans' Hall o

l	Fame Foundation, members of the Kentucky Veterans' Hall of Fame executive
2	committee, members of the Governor's staff, members of the Kentucky Veterans'
3	Hall of Fame staff, and the commissioner of the Kentucky Department of
4	Veterans' Affairs, shall not be eligible for induction into the Kentucky Veterans'
5	Hall of Fame until one (1) year after they have left their position. The executive
5	committee may waive the one (1) year requirement for nominees over the age of
7	seventy (70) years.
