- 3           Whereas, October 28, 2019, is recognized nationally as First Responders  
4       Appreciation Day; and
- 5           Whereas, first responders include all professional and volunteer police, fire,  
6       and emergency medical services (EMS) personnel; and
- 7           Whereas, first responders risk their safety on a daily basis to protect the public  
8       from threats and emergency situations and provide life-saving services; and
- 9           Whereas, first responders stand ready to serve and protect the public 24 hours  
10      a day; and
- 11          Whereas, there are approximately 4.6 million first responders in the United  
12      States serving in disciplines such as law enforcement, emergency management,  
13      emergency medical services, fire and rescue, and public works; and
