

1 2 3	(b) (1) A member who qualifies because of the member's elected or appointed position is a member of the Council only during the member's term of office in the elected or appointed position.
4	(2) A member appointed:
5 6	(i) under subsection (a)(3) of this section, serves at the pleasure of the commissioners for the county that the member represents;
7 8	(ii) under subsection (a)(4) of this section, shall reside in the member county that the member represents; and
9	(iii) under subsection (a)(6) of this section:
10 11	1. serves at the pleasure of the commissioners who appointed the member; and
12 13	2. has the same term as the commissioners who appointed the member.
14 15	(3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
16 17 18	(4) Except for an ex officio member, a member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
19 20	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
