Dear Mr. Skoric:

Reading *Wyoming v. Livingston*, 443 F.3d 1211 (10th Cir. 2006), led me to conclude you are willing to prosecute federal officials when warranted.

Enclosed is a self-explanatory letter and enclosure I sent my state Attorney General regarding prosecuting Centers for Disease Control officials under Utah's reckless endangerment statute.

I am sending this letter for you to consider either investigating, screening, and filing under Wyoming's analogous statute, Wyoming Statutes, section 6-2-504 (reckless endangerment), if still within the statute of limitations, and if the applicable jurisdictional statute permits (crime outside state causes an element in state), or passing along this idea to a state or county prosecutor interested in exploring this possibility or similar ones.

I have not received a response from my state Attorney General either way. My letter was sent only recently.

The views herein in are mine, not those of my employer for whom I serve as a municipal prosecutor.
